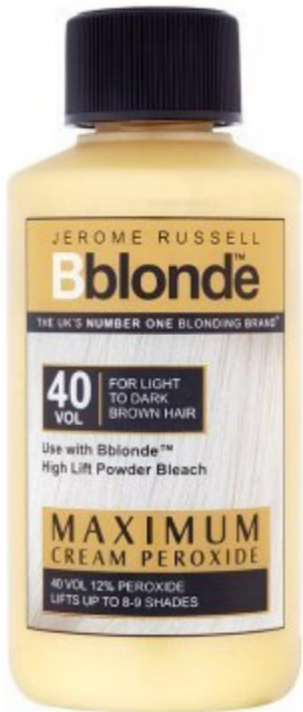


Bleaching the Radio Knobs and Buttons

The knobs and buttons on the AM Studebaker radio for my Wagonaire have turned a tobacco brown. I read somewhere on the SDC Forum that a hair salon product from Great Britain was the best way to bleach the plastic knobs and buttons back to gleaming white.



I bought the cream peroxide through Amazon. It ships from London. It is a hair salon product. The power bleach came from Walmart. When mixed with the cream hydrogen peroxide and brushed on, exposed to UV (I am using natural sunshine), and repeated as necessary the plastic knobs and buttons become totally white.
